Everyone's Welcome– The programs that we offer are open to anyone that would like to participate, regardless of ability, experience, race, gender, or sexual orientation.

Employment Opportunities- Anyone interested in part-time or seasonal employment with the Portage Park & Recreation Department should visit our website, or contact our department for information about open positions.

You Snooze....You Lose- Nothing kills a program quicker than waiting until the last minute to register. If we do not meet the minimum number of participants by the registration deadline, the program will be canceled. We also set registration maximums for each program based on staff, equipment, and space, so be sure to register early in order to reserve your spot before they are all gone!

Say 'Cheese'- For program promotional purposes, photographs may be taken of participants. If you do not wish to have your photo, or photos of your children taken, please notify our department.

Residents vs. Non-Residents – All program and park shelter rentals will list 2 prices under the description. (example-\$15/\$25). The first price is for residents of the City of Portage or Pacific Township. The second price is for non-residents (Lewiston, Caledonia, Fort Winnebago, Pardeeville, etc.). Non-resident fees are charged to help our department continue to maintain our programs and facilities.

Scholarships – The City of Portage wishes to offer our programs and activities to all area children. If financial assistance is needed for a child's participation, please contact our department for more information. Park Shelter Rentals and select programs do not qualify for our scholarship program.

Typos/Mistakes– Occasionally, there may be an error in days, times, registration requirements, pricing, or location in our program descriptions. When such errors occur, our staff will do everything possible to correct the situation promptly. Our department reserves the right to change program schedules as needed to accommodate demand or school/community conflicts.

Program Refund Policy– Refunds will be granted if requests are made seven (7) days prior to the scheduled start of the activity. Please contact our department if you have questions regarding refunds due to medical or unavoidable circumstances. All refunds carry a \$5.00 processing fee.

Facility Rental Refund Policy – Refunds for facility rentals will be granted if requests are made thirty (30) days prior to scheduled rental. Extenuating circumstances are occasionally considered. All refunds carry a \$10.00 processing fee.

PARK PROJECT UPDATE

NEW PLAYGROUND AT COLLIPP-WORDEN

The playground equipment at Collipp-Worden Park is scheduled to be replaced excluding the zipline and swing bay that were installed in 2021. The existing equipment was installed in the 90's and is ready to be replaced. Construction will begin in the Fall of 2023 of the spring of 2024. Be sure to follow our Facebook page for updates.

ACCESSIBLE PATHS

We will be installing an accessible path at Pine Meadow Park from Hamilton Street down to the Pickleball Courts and shelter, as well as installing an accessible path at Collipp-Worden Park from the parking lot to shelter #2. We hope for construction to be completed by the end of 2023.

POCKET PARK

The City has received a Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) 'Vibrant Spaces' matching grant in the amount of \$50,000. The funds will be going towards the construction of a pocket park at the intersection of E Wisconsin and Edgewater. We are hoping for construction to begin in 2023 with completion by June 15, 2024.

Fall Clean-Up: October 7, 2023; 8:00a.m. – 2:00p.m. at the Public Works Garage located at 616 Washington Street.

Guidelines for Brush Collection: Remaining Brush Collection will take place September 11th, October 2nd, and November 6th. Brush needs to be out in your boulevard by 7am Monday morning to be picked up that week. Leaf and grass clipping bags must be separated from the brush and be out by 7am Monday morning as well. Leaf and grass bags may be collected separately from our brush collection.

Waste Water Reminders: If you have a sanitary back-up after 4:30pm Monday-Friday, or on a Saturday, Sunday, or a holiday, please call 608-742-2171.

Recycling: Columbia County Recycling is the City of Portage's contractor for garbage and recycling collection. Please visit our City website for information on what can and can't be recycled at https://www.portagewi.gov/garbage-and-recycling/.

Additionally, the City maintains a drop off center for residents to use for household recyclables as a supplement to curbside collection on Washington Street. Please note, this drop off site is monitored by video surveillance to ensure drop off guidelines are followed. Guidelines for drop off are posted on-site.

Water Utility: Crews will be performing fall hydrant flushing between September 4th, 2023 and October 27th, 2023. If you experience any discoloration in your water during this time, simply run your faucet with cold water until the water clears.

Remaining 2023 Construction/Improvement Projects

W. Conant Street Reconstruction: Specific construction dates are to be determined. The project will consist of the complete reconstruction of the roadway, which will include storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water utility, sidewalk, curb & gutter, and an 8-foot-wide walking path along the Wisconsin River between W. Prospect Street and Pierce Street. The project is scheduled for substantial completion by the end of November of this year.
